


Left in Cars

The Timber Mesa Fire and Medical District wants to remind the public to never leave a child alone in a car, not even for a minute. Always make sure your car is locked when you're not in it so that children don't get in on their own.

The temperature inside a car can increase significantly in a short period of time.

Create reminders for yourself by putting something in the back of your car next to your child such as a briefcase, a purse or a cell phone that is needed at your final destination. This is especially important if you're not following your normal routine.
